Ideas for everyone

Give a one-off lump sum Giving a one-off sum immediately would be great as it will enable us to show the diocese we can raise 80% of costs. Or perhaps wou can pledge a one-off sum at a specific date in the future (ideally before we begin in summer 2024)?

Give regularly by Standing Order You may want to give a sum by monthly standing order e.g. giving £1,200 through payments of £100 a month. Consistent regular giving by Standing Orders is great to help our ongoing ----- cashflow.

"Give it up for Gateway" Could you give up something you regularly spend money on and give this amount to Gateway?



 Costa Discipleship Giving up a coffee or sandwich each day could raise £80 a month, and with Gift Aid would be £1,200 a year.

- Donate a week's holiday If you usually have several weeks holiday a year, you could stay home one week and donate the cost to Gateway.
- Donate a month If you're a landlord of a house/holiday home or have other regular income, you could donate a month's income to Gateway.

Fundraising Fun Fundraising activities like sponsored runs, bake sales, garage sales 🗲 etc. are great ways, especially for kids and young people, to raise funds for the project and a really fun way of making it happen!

Sell Some Stuff You may have unwanted stuff you could sell on ebay / Facebook Marketplace, or a potential Da Vinci hanging around in the attic gathering dust. Could you "Sell Some Stuff" for Gateway? eb

Godly giving As Christians all giving is part of our worship. It shows our thanks to God for all he has given us and our desire to use all that we have to serve him. Because of this, anything we give should be done with prayer (asking God what he is calling us to give) and thankfulness (God loves cheerful and generous givers – 2 Cor 9.6ff). So do PRAY about how God is leading you to give to Gateway.

The 'Feeding of the 5000' and the 'Parable of the Talents' remind us that every gift given with love, and placed into God's hands, can grow immeasurably more than we imagine (Eph 3.20).

Ideas for some people

Reclaimed tax If you are a higher rate



taxpayer you could consider giving the tax you can reclaim from your charitable giving.

Leave a Legacy Consider including Christ will and Test Church and Gateway as a beneficiary in your will. Future legacies will help us pay off any loans or mortgages. This is only for those considering making or updating a will.

Give a loan The most helpful loans would be



Interest-free, and would only be **EBLEN** considered if necessary to enable LOAN essential work to be done. Contact us if you might be willing to consider this. This will only be right for those with disposable cash they are happy to lend.

Release equity with a mortgage

If you have low mortgage payments, large equity in your home and capacity to take on a higher

mortgage payment, it may be possible to increase your mortgage to enable a gift to be given. This will only be right for those who've paid off a large amount of their mortgage and should only be considered after taking financial



larget £4.99m is the professional estimate for Phase 1 and we hope to raise the majority through generous congregational gifts large and small - every gift is valuable and adds up. We will also aim to raise some money through grants/public money, and if necessary, through loans and a mortgage (though we hope this will be kept to a minimum).

Lots of little gifts makes a lot

Our target sounds like a lot, but lots of different sized gifts given over a longer period of time add up...

Important Firstly, this giving does need to be in addition to any usual giving to Christ Church. We are committed to maintaining our regular mission and ministry during this time and your regular giving enables this.

Secondly, whilst we know our giving will need to be deep and sacrificial to enable the project, please only give or pledge money you can afford (or know will be available and affordable when promised). We don't want anyone to struggle because of their gift.

Remember if you pay UK tax, we can claim 25% Gift aid on your gift * e.g. £80 gift becomes £100!
